AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MT. CRESTED BUTTE, COLORADO AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1, SERIES 2021, TO MODIFY PART II (1) AND (2) SPEED REGULATIONS, SECTION 1101 SPEED LIMITS AND SECTION 1101(12)

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 1, Series 2021, the Town Council adopted the 2020 edition of the Model Traffic Code (MTC) with certain additions and deletions; and

WHEREAS, Part II (1) and (2), Section 1101 Speed Limits, contains different speed limits for different roadways within the Town; and

WHEREAS, Town staff has reviewed the Section and finds that it is confusing as to descriptions, and allows for speeds greater than prudent on certain roadways; and

WHEREAS, Town staff has suggested further amendments to Section 1101 (1) and (2) and 1101 (2), which Council agrees are appropriate.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MT. CRESTED BUTTE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Part 11(1) and (2), Speed Regulations, is hereby amended to read as follows:

1101 Speed Limits.

- (1) Unless otherwise listed in subsection (2) and signed, the speed limit within the Town of Mt Crested Butte is 15 miles per hour.
- (2) Specific streets and street sections that vary from the 15 mile per hour limit are:
 - a. Thirty (30) miles per hour on Gothic Road from the southern Town boundary to Snowmass Road;
 - b. Twenty-five (25) miles per hour on Gothic Road north of Snowmass Road;
 - c. Twenty-five (25) miles per hour on Prospect Road.

Section 2. Section 1101(12) is amended to read as follows:

Regardless of the speed limit, drivers are expected to reduce their speed to a reasonable and prudent speed depending on street and weather conditions.

Section 3. Severability. Should any section, clause, phrase, or provision of this ordinance be ruled invalid or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, it is hereby declared the intent of the Town Council of the Town of Mt. Crested Butte, Colorado, that the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall be given full force and effect if it is possible to do so.

INTRODUCED, READ AND APPROVED at a regular meeting of the Town Council on the 18th day of October, 2022 at Mt. Crested Butte, Colorado.

PASSED, ADOPTED AND APPROVED upon second reading at a public meeting of the Town Council this 15th day of November, 2022 at Mt. Crested Butte, Colorado.
