A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MT. CRESTED BUTTE, COLORADO, ADOPTING THE MILL LEVY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2023, BEGINNING THE FIRST DAY OF JANUARY 2023 AND ENDING THE LAST DAY OF DECEMBER 2023

WHEREAS, the mill levy for the Town of Mt. Crested Butte, Colorado, is presently 10.378 on an assessed valuation of \$121,210,260; and

WHEREAS, the assessed valuation of taxable property for the taxable year 2023 in the Town of Mt. Crested Butte, as returned by the County Assessor of Gunnison County, Colorado, is \$118,452,270; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that it is in the public interest that no adjustment is necessary in the existing mill levy for the upcoming year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MT. CRESTED BUTTE, COLORADO:


Section 1. That the Town Council has determined that the proper total mill levy upon each dollar of assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town shall be 10.378.

Section 2. That for the purpose of defraying expenses of the Capital Projects Fund during the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2023, and ending December 31, 2023, there is hereby levied a tax of 5.378 mills upon each dollar of total assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town of Mt. Crested Butte, Colorado, for the year 2023.

Section 3. That for the purpose of defraying expenses of the General Fund during the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2023, and ending December 31, 2023, there is hereby levied a tax of 5.000 mills upon each dollar of total assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town of Mt. Crested Butte, Colorado, for the year 2023.

INTRODUCED, READ AND ADOPTED at a regular meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Mt. Crested Butte on the 6th day of December 2022.
